Clear instruction (postsurgical exercises, walking with crutches) and information about the content of the rehabilitation program increases self-efficacy during rehabilitation, stimulates early recovery of knee function, decreases expected postsurgical pain and creates a realistic view about the rehabilitation process [6, 8, 22, 51]
